In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

Henry S. Shepard having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Ausable, Michigan, and that Henry McDonald, resides at Medford, Mass., and that Thurston Priest, resides at Weston Corners, Mass., and that they compose the firm of Soud, Priest & Shepard and that they are in the firm named as said Citizens of the United States sole owners of the Jug Propeller or vessel called the S. J. Day of Ausable whereof Eugene Wilson is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Jug Propeller or vessel was built at Buffalo in the year 1866, as appears by the Certificate of Chas. Bidwell her builder now on file in this office

And A. S. Scriven, Surveyor, having certified that the said Jug Propeller or vessel has on deck and no mast, and that her length is 47 feet, her breadth 12 feet, her depth 5 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 16 tons and 08 hundredths,
