Y. in the year 1864 as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port dated Sept 25, 1865, and numbered 359, now surrendered having changed Owners.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Sloop Propeller or vessel has one deck and no mast, and that her length is 33 feet, her breadth 7 feet, her depth 4 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 7 tons and 31 hundredths,
