sole owners of the Schooner or vessel called the Citizen, of Buffalo whereof Michael Mitchell is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Erie, Pa. in the year 1847, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment, at the port of Erie, Pa. dated Feb. 15, 1866, and numbered 9, now surrendered having changed owners and District.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 87 feet, her breadth 22 feet, her depth 8 feet, her height 70 feet, and that she measures 116 tons and 27 hundredths,
