Citizens of the United States sole owners of the Brig or vessel called the William Treat of Buffalo whereof William Bain is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Brig or vessel was built at Euclid Ohio, in the year 1856, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment, at this Port dated July 2, 1866, and numbered 164, now surrendered having changed owners.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 146 feet, her breadth 35 feet, her depth 11 feet, her height 12 feet, and that she measures 289 tons and 97 hundredths,
