Citizen of the United States' sole owner of the Barge or vessel called the J. S. Keeler of Buffalo whereof John D. Davison is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Barge or vessel was built at Port Ryerse, Canada, in the year 1863, as appears by the Certificate of her Canadian Registry. This Enrollment being issued by direction of the Secretary of the Treasury dated Aug. 4, 1866. Under the Act of Congress of July 26, 1866, and G. L. Pullman, Surveyor of Chicago, Ill. having certified that

the said Barge or vessel has one deck and the mast, and that her length is 136 feet, her breadth 26 feet, her depth 13 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 338 tons and 46 hundredths,
