In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864; and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

Y. and owns three eighths (3/8) and that Isaac Eaton resides at the same place and owns one eighth (1/8) and that Richard Euter resides at Chicago, Ill. and owns one fourth (1/4) and that Thomas Durk resides at Cleveland, Ohio and owns one eighth (1/8) and that William Harding resides at Cleveland, Ohio and owns one eighth (1/8) and that they are Citizens of the United States sole owner of the Sloop Prop. or vessel called the "Houle Dole" of Buffalo, whereof Isaac Eaton is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Sloop Prop. or vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1866, as appears by the Certificate of John C. Carroll, Shipwright, her builder, on file in this office.

And A. H. Scriven, Surveyor, having certified that the said Sloop Propeller or vessel has one deck and no mast, and that her length is 62 feet, her breadth 14 feet, her depth 7 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 28 - tons and - 65 - hundredths,
