In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and owns one third (1/3) and that Sherburne B. Eaton resides at Cleveland, Ohio, and owns the remaining (2/3) two thirds, and that they are

sole owner of the Barque or vessel called the Haverly of Buffalo whereof P. B. Locke is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Barque or vessel was built at Sackett Harbor in the year 1853, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment, at this Port, dated April 22, 1866, and numbered 67, now surrendered having changed owners, and said Enrollment, having certified that

the said Barque or vessel has one deck and the mast, and that her length is 134 feet, her breadth 25 feet, her depth 10 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 262 tons and 66 hundredths,
