Citizen of the United States sole owner of the Canal Boat vessel called the "Dordelia" of Buffalo, whereof he is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat vessel was built at North Bay, N. Y. in the year 1863, as appears by the Certificate of J. A. Bovell, Jr. Shipwright, her builder, dated Sept. 19, 1866, on file in this office.

And A. H. Scriwen, Surveyor, having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has one deck and no mast, and that her length is 95 feet, her breadth 17 feet, her depth 7 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 99 tons and 34 hundredths,
