Case of Buffalo whereof he is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat vessel was built at Rochester, N. Y. in the year 1861, as appears by the Certificate of George Watson, Shipwright, dated September 25, 1866, on file in this office.

And A. H. Scriven, Surveyor, having certified that the said Canal Boat vessel has one deck and no mast, and that her length is 96 feet, her breadth 17 feet, her depth 9 feet, her height 9 feet, and that she measures 118 - tons and 94 - hundredths,
