Y. in the year 1860, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment, at the port of Rochester, N. Y. dated April 24, 1862. Raimond J. And A. H. Scriven, Surveyor having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has one deck and no mast, and that her length is 95 feet, her breadth 17 feet, her depth 10 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 141 tons and 57 hundredths,
