Y. in the year 1864, as appears by the Certificate of J. K. Baker, shipwright, her builder, dated Sept 18, 1866, on file in this office.

And A. B. Scriven, Surveyor, having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has one deck and no mast, and that her length is 95 feet, her breadth 17 feet, her depth 8 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 118, - tons and 44 - hundredths,
