In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N.Y., and that Gustavus P. Hosmer resides at Lockport, N.Y. and that they are

each one half part Citizens of the United States sole owners of the Barge or vessel called the "Forrest King" of Buffalo whereof Wm. H. Lottitt is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Barge or vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1866, as appears by the Certificate of George Campbell, shipwright, her builder, dated November 1, 1866, on file in the Office.

And Alongs H. Scriven, Surveyor, having certified that the said Barge or vessel has One deck and the masts and that her length is 160 feet, her breadth 28 feet, her depth 9 feet, her height 1 feet, and that she measures 245 tons and 46 hundredths,
