In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

N. G. Kinslow

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at New York City, N.Y. and owns five eighths (5/8) and that Henry G. Kinslow resides at Buffalo, N.Y. and in trust for Mary Ann Kinslow who resides at the City of New York two eighths (2/8) that the said Henry G. Kinslow in trust for Caroline S. Williams who resides at Buffalo, N.Y. owns the remaining one eighth (1/8) and the said things are Citizens of the United States sole owners of the Schooner or vessel called the "Lucinda Van Valkenburg" of Buffalo whereof George G. Morris is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Tonawanda, N.Y. in the year 1862 as appears by the Certificate of her Temporary Enrollment, at the port of Chicago, Ill. dated November 6, 1866, and numbered 156, now surrendered having arrived at home port.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 138 feet, her breadth 26 feet, her depth 12 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 301 tons and 66 hundredths,

that she is a Schooner has a round stern and stem figure head And the said N. G.
