sole owners of the Scow Schooner or vessel called the "J. C. Hille" of Buffalo whereof John Blumet

is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Scow Schooner or vessel was built at Fairport, Ohio in the year 1861, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of Cleveland, Ohio dated September 12, 1865, and numbered 281. Now surrendered having changed Owners & District.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Scow Schooner or vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 102 feet, her breadth 22 feet, her depth 6 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 124 tons and 79 hundredths,
