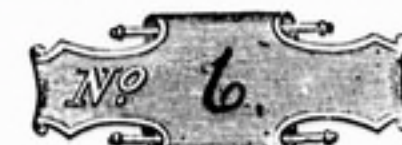

In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and that he is a

Citizen of the United States  
sole owner of the Brig or vessel called the Frontier City of Buffalo, whereof Charles Killiam is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Brig or vessel was built at Oswego, N. Y. in the year 1860, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of Oswego, N. Y., dated March 28, 1865, and numbered 1, now surrendered having changed Owners & District, and said Enrollment.

Having certified that the said Brig or vessel has One deck and two masts, and that her length is 115 feet, her breadth 23 feet, her depth 9 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 200 tons and 93 hundredths,
