In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

Thomas Quinn,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and owns One sixth (1/6) and that Rosanna Francis resides at the same place and owns One sixth (1/6) and that Patrick M. M. M. resides at the same place and owns One third (1/3) and that John D. Molloy resides at the same place and owns One third (1/3) and that they are Citizens of the United States & sole owners of the Schooner or vessel called the Moselle of Buffalo whereof John D. Molloy is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1855, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated February 19, 1866, and numbered 7, now surrendered having changed Owners and said Enrollment. having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 127 feet, her breadth 25 feet, her depth 10 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 245 tons and 21 hundredths,
