In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 7th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

Peter C. Stambach

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and owns Four eighths (4/8) and that P. A. Wagner resides at the same place, and owns Three eighths (3/8) and that Alexander McArthur resides at the same place, and owns the remaining One eighth (1/8) and that they all are Citizens of the United States & sole owners of the Schooner or vessel called the "William Fiske"

of Buffalo whereof Peter C. Stambach is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1856, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated March 1. 1867, and numbered 9, now surrendered having changed Owners.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner, or vessel has One deck and two masts, and that her length is 120 feet, her breadth 28 feet, her depth 12 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 208 tons and 52 hundredths,
