In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and owns three fourths (3/4) and that William S. McRay resides at Chicago, Ill., and owns the remaining One fourth (1/4) and that they are

Citizens of the United States sole owners of the Barge or vessel called the Waitland, of Buffalo whereof Harry Bonner, is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Barge or vessel was built at Goderich, Ont. in the year 1861, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated October 19, 1866, and Numbered 273.

Now surrendered having changed Owners, and said Enrollment having certified that the said Barge or vessel has One deck and the mast, and that her length is 132 feet, her breadth 25 feet, her depth 11 feet, and that she measures 252 tons and 66 hundredths,
