In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and owns Five Eighths (5/8) and that Solomon S. Guthrie resides at the same place, and owns Two Eighths (2/8) and George R. No. Bartney resides at the same place, and owns the remaining One Eighth (1/8) and that they are Citizens of the United States sole owner of the Barque or vessel called the P. G. Sherman of Buffalo, whereof George R. No. Bartney is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Barque or vessel was built at Cleveland, Ohio in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated April 17, 1866, and Numbered 53. Now surrendered having changed Owner.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Barque or vessel has One deck and Two masts, and that her length is 150 feet, her breadth 30 feet, her depth 12 feet, and that she measures 406 tons and 42 hundredths,
