In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and owns One half (1/2) and that Edward Beron resides at the same place, and owns Two sixths (2/6) and Mr J. Coleman resides at the same place, and owns the remaining Two sixths (2/6) and that they all are Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Schooner vessel called the "Eli Bates" of Buffalo whereof Mr J. Coleman is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Erie, Penn. in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment, at this Port, dated May 18, 1865, and numbered 143. Now surrendered having changed Owners.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 135 feet, her breadth 25 feet, her depth 10 feet, and that she measures 264 tons and 91 hundredths,
