In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

Henry B. Kinslow

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and owns in trust for Mrs. Caroline S. Killiam who resides at the same place. One half (1/2) and that H. B. Kinslow resides at New York, N. Y. and owns One fourth (1/4) and that Mrs. Mary A. Kinslow resides at the same place and the remaining One fourth (1/4) what Citizens of the United States sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the "Lucinda Van Sackenburg" of Buffalo whereof H. B. Kinslow

is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Onawanda, N. Y. in the year 1862, as appears by the certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated November 16, 1866, and Numbered 202.

Now surrendered having changed Owner and said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 128 feet, her breadth 26 feet, her depth 12 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 201 tons and 66 hundredths,
