In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

John S. Koyes

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and owns one half (1/2) and that Mark Maria K. Reed resides at the same place, and owns three eighths (3/8) and that James Knight resides at the same place, and owns the remaining one eighth (1/8) and that they are in Citizens of the United States sole owners of the Barge or vessel called the "Sunshine" of Buffalo whereof James Knight is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Barge or vessel was built at East Saginaw, Mich. in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated January 16, 1866, and numbered 2. Now surrendered having changed Owners.

And said Enrollment, having certified that the said Barge or vessel has one deck and three masts and that her length is 159 feet, her breadth 29 feet, her depth 11 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 389 tons and 81 hundredths,
