Y. dated April 21, 1866, and numbered 13. Now surrendered having changed Owners & District. And said Enrollment, having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has Onedeck and twomasts and that her length is 118 feet, her breadth 24 feet, her depth 10 feet, and that she measures 223 tons and 68 hundredths,
