Hale," of Buffalo whereof William Fletcher is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Cleveland, Ohio in the year 1857, as appears by the certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated October 16, 1866, and numbered 270. Now surrendered having changed Owner, and said Enrollment, having certified that

the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 123 feet, her breadth 28 feet, her depth 11 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 248 tons and 90 hundredths,
