In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Milwaukee, Wis. and owns One fourth (1/4) and that Henry Fischebeck resides at the same place, and owns One fourth (1/4) and that James Porter resides at the same place, and owns the remaining One half (1/2) and that they are Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Dug Prop. or vessel called the "American Eagle" of Milwaukee whereof James Moody is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Dug Prop. or vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1865, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated July 23, 1866, and numbered 176. Now surrendered having changed District & Owners and said Enrollment.
