In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and that Alvin Starkey resides at the same place, and that they are

sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the H. A. Richmond, of Buffalo whereof George S. Day is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1861, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment, at this Port, dated April 20, 1866, and numbered 63. Now surrendered having changed Owners and said Enrollment.
