In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

having taken or subscribed the Oath, required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Chicago, Ill., and that he is Agent for John J. Edwards of St. Joseph, Mo., who is a

sole owner of the Propeller or vessel called the Benton of Chicago whereof Robert Jones is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller or vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1867, as appears by the Certificate of Hitchcock and Gibson, shipwrights, her builders, dated April 12, 1867. On file in this Office.

And Alonzo H. Scriven, surveyor having certified that the said Propeller or vessel has two deck and no mast, and that her length is 146 feet, her breadth 28 feet, her depth 8 feet, her height 7 feet, and that she measures 418 tons and 75 hundredths,
