In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Chicago, Ill. and owns One third (1/3) and that Peter Schneider resides at the same place, and owns One third (1/3) and that Albert Walter resides at the same place, and owns the remaining One third (1/3) and that they are Citizens of the United States sole owners of the Brig or vessel called the Empire State of Chicago whereof William M^c Donald is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Brig or vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated April 25, 1866, and numbered 81.

Now surrendered having changed Owners & District and said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 131 feet, her breadth 29 feet, her depth 13 feet, her height 13 feet, and that she measures 298 tons and 59 hundredths,
