In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo, N.Y.* and owns *One half (1/2)* and that *Robert Anderson* resides at *Cleveland, Ohio* and owns *One fourth (1/4)* and that *Solon S. Ramage* resides at the same place, and owns the remaining *One fourth (1/4)* and that they are *in* Citizens of the United States sole owners of the *Barge* or vessel called the *Champion* of *Buffalo* whereof *N. H. Barclay* is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said *Barge* or vessel was built at *Cleveland Ohio* in the year *1862*, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of *Chicago, Ill.* dated *April 20, 1865* and numbered *712*.

Now surrendered having changed Owners & District, and said Enrollment having certified that the said *Barge* or vessel has *One* deck and *two* masts and that her length is *182* feet, her breadth *22* feet, her depth *12* feet, her height *10* feet, and that she measures *585* tons and *59* hundredths,
