Y. dated July 14, 1866, and Number 44. And said Enrollment having certified that

the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 91 feet, her breadth 23 feet, her depth 8 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 132 tons and 27 hundredths,
