Richmond executrix of the estate of the late Dean Richmond resides at Batavia, N. Y. and owns the remaining Three fourths (3/4) and that they are

Citizens of the United States sole owners of the Propeller or vessel called the Chicago of Buffalo whereof Edmund Conlon is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller or vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1855, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated May 5, 1865, and numbered 119.

Now surrendered having changed Managing and said Enrollment having certified that Owners the said Propeller or vessel has two decks and one mast, and

that her length is 198 feet, her breadth 21 feet, her depth 11 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 925 tons and 64 hundredths,
