Y. and owns the remaining two eighths (2/8) and that they are — Citizens of the United States sole owners of the Schooner or vessel called the Aldebaran, of Buffalo whereof Isaac Gage is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Huron, Ohio in the year 1852, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment, at this Port, dated October 2, 1866, and numbered 251. Now surrendered having changed Owners.
