In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

Truman G. Avery

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and owns One sixth (1/6) and that David S. Bennett resides at the same place and owns Two sixths (2/6) and that G. H. Horton resides at the same place, and owns One fourth (1/4), and that Erastus Corning resides at Albany, N. Y. and owns the other One fourth (1/4) and ^{that they are} Citizens of the United States, sole owner of the Barge or vessel called the "Erastus Corning" of Buffalo whereof P. B. Locke is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Barge or vessel was built at Tonawanda, N. Y. in the year 1867, as appears by the Certificate of J. K. Jones, shipwright her builder, dated May 8. 1867, on file in this Office.

And Monzo H. Scriven, Surveyor, having certified that the said Barge or vessel has One deck and three masts, and that her length is 204 feet, her breadth 25 feet, her depth 14 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 832 tons and 43 hundredths,
