In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

Henry A. Richmond, having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and that Mrs Sarah E. King resides at the same place and that they are

Bentley of Buffalo. whereof Benjamin Hammond is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Fairport, Ohio in the year 1867, as appears by the Certificate of her Temporary Enrollment at the Port of Cleveland, Ohio dated April 15, 1867, and numbered 2. Now surrendered vessel having arrived at home port, and said Enrollment, having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and three masts and that her length is 178 feet, her breadth 24 feet, her depth 12 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 574 tons and 58 hundredths,
