In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and that James H. Lee resides at the same place, and each own One third (1/3) and that Frank Lee resides at Lancaster, Erie County, N. Y. and owns the remaining One third (1/3) and they are Citizens of the United States sole owner of the Sloop Propeller vessel called the Robert Dunbar of Buffalo whereof Thomas Dunbar is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Sloop Propeller vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1867, as appears by the Certificate of Lewis S. Harford, shipwright her builder, dated May 16, 1867. On file in this Office.

And George H. Scriven, Surveyor, having certified that the said Sloop Propeller vessel has One deck and No. mast, and that her length is 42 feet, her breadth 11 feet, her depth 5 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures Eleven tons and 60 hundredths,
