In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and owns One half (1/2) and that N. H. Barclay resides at the same place, and owns One fourth (1/4) & that Rollin G. Brown resides at New York and owns the other One fourth (1/4) and that they are Citizens of the United States sole owners of the Canal Boat vessel called the Volga, of Buffalo whereof J. H. Crawford is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat or vessel was built at Chaca, N. Y. in the year 1856, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of Oswego, N. Y. dated June 22. 1865. and Numbered 215. Now surrendered having changed District. And said Enrollment having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has One deck and No. mast, and that her length is 95 feet, her breadth 17 feet, her depth 7 feet, her height 7 feet, and that she measures 98 tons and 40 hundredths,
