In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 17th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y., and owns One sixth (1/6) and that Maria M. Littlejohn resides at the same place, and owns Three sixths (3/6) and that Francis A. Dane resides at New York and owns Two sixths (2/6) and that they are Citizens of the United States sole owners of the Canal Boat or vessel called the Anna of Buffalo, whereof Theodore H. Kells is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat or vessel was built at Covert, N. Y. in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of Oswego, N. Y. dated June 12. 1865, and Numbered 132. Now surrendered having changed District. And said Enrollment having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has One deck and No. mast, and that her length is 94 feet, her breadth 17 feet, her depth 8 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 120 tons and 62 hundredths,
