In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and that Nicholas Delfer resides at the same place and that they are

(each one half part) Citizens of the United States sole owners of the Canal Boat or vessel called the Dock Pierce of Buffalo whereof Mathias Gardner is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat or vessel was built at Lockport, N. Y. in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of H. J. Brady, Shipwright, her builder, dated June 10, 1867. On file in this Office.

And Alonzo H. Scriven, Surveyor, having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has One deck and No mast, and that her length is 95 feet, her breadth 17 feet, her depth 8 feet, her height 8 feet, and that she measures 124 tons and 22 hundredths,
