Y.* in the year 1867, as appears by the certificate of *J. K. Jones* shipwright, her builder, dated July 5, 1867, On file in this Office.

And *Alonzo H. Scriven* surveyor having certified that the said *Barge* or vessel has *One deck* and *two masts* and that her length is *194* feet her breadth *20* feet her depth *11* feet her height *10* feet and that she measures *524* tons and *24* hundredths,
