is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Brig or vessel was built at Euclid, Ohio in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of her Temporary Register at the Port of Milwaukee, Wis. dated June 24, 1867, & numbered 1. Now surrendered, vessel having arrived at home port.
