Langley is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1867 as appears by the Certificate of Hitchcock & Gibbons, shipwrights, her builder, dated July 8, 1867. On file in this Office.

And Alonzo H. Scriven, Surveyor having certified that the said Propeller or vessel has 2 Decks and One mast, and that her length is 150 feet, her breadth 28 feet, her depth 9 feet, her height 10 feet and that she measures 472 tons and 92 hundredths,
