In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1804, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864,

Christopher Burns, having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and that Joseph Burns resides at Laginaw, Mich. and that they are

(each one half part) Citizens of the United States sole owners of the G. Boat or vessel called the G. L. Satterlee of Buffalo whereof Christopher Burns is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said G. Boat or vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of New York, dated April 14, 1866, & numbered 271. Now surrendered having changed Owners District.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has One deck and No mast, and that her length is 95 feet her breadth 17 feet her depth 8 feet her height 10 feet and that she measures 126 tons and 84 hundredths,
