Now surrendered having changed Owners.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or vessel has two decks and one mast, and that her length is 176 feet ⁵/₁₀ her breadth 28 ⁴/₁₀ feet her depth 10 ⁷/₁₀ feet her height ¹⁰/₁₀ feet and that she measures 656 tons and 26 hundredths,
