is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Barque or vessel was built at Black River, Ohio, in the year 1861, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated April 6, 1867, and Numbered 21. Now surrendered having changed Owners

And said Enrollment, having certified that the said Barque or vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 144 feet her breadth 20 feet her depth 11 feet her height and that she measures 261 tons and 48 hundredths,
