In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and owns Four eighths (4/8) of that Nelson Holland as executor of the estate of the late Selim Leach, owns Three eighths (3/8), and that Isaac Gage resides at Silver Creek, N. Y. and owns the remaining One Eighth (1/8), and that they are Citizens of the United States

sole owner of the Schooner vessel called the Alderbaran of Buffalo whereof Isaac Gage is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Huron, Ohio in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment, at this Port, dated May 6, 1867, and numbered 62. Now surrendered having changed Owners.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 123 feet her breadth 28 feet her depth 9 feet her height 10 feet and that she measures 251 tons and 25 hundredths,
