Littlejohn resides at the same place, and owns Three sixths (3/6) and that Frances B. Dane resides at New York, and owns Two sixths (2/6) and that they are Citizens of the United States

sole owner of the Canal Boat vessel called the Russian of Buffalo whereof T. K. Kells is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a citizen of the United States, and that the said B. Boat or vessel was built at Oswego, N. Y. in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of Oswego, N. Y. dated May 22, 1865 and Numbered 17. Now surrendered having changed District.

And said Enrollment, having certified that the said Canal Boat vessel has One deck and No mast, and that her length is 95 feet 5/10 her breadth 17 feet 4/10 her depth 8 feet 6/10 her height 10 feet and that she measures 117 tons and 97 hundredths,
