Now surrendered License having expired, while out of Home District. And said Enrollment, having certified that the said Brig or vessel has One deck and two masts, and that her length is 140 feet her breadth 29 feet her depth 10 feet her height 10 feet and that she measures 206 tons and 22 hundredths,
