sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the William Grandy of Buffalo whereof H. M. Jones is at present Master, and as he hath sworn

is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Cleveland, O. in the year 1867, as appears by the Certificate of her Temporary Enrollment at the Port of Cleveland, Ohio, dated Sept 14, 1867 & numbered 12. Said schooner having arrived at Home Port.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and 2 masts and that her length is 165 feet her breadth 32 feet her depth 11 feet her height 10 feet and that she measures 464 tons and 97 hundredths,
