In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 17th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864,

James Davidson, having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N.Y. and that he is a

Citizen of the United States sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the Gamecock of Buffalo whereof he is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1856, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment, at this Port dated Sept 30, 1867, and numbered 297. Now surrendered having changed Owners.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 109 feet her breadth 26 feet her depth 9 feet her height 10 feet and that she measures 170 tons and 24 hundredths,
