In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864,

James K. Davison having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y., and that Wm. C. Davison, and Hiram H. Smith reside at the same place, and that they are

(each One third (1/3) part) Citizens of the United States sole owners of the Schooner or vessel called the Resolute of Buffalo whereof James K. Davison is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or vessel was built at Black River in the year 1856, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated April 22, 1867, and Numbered 57.

Now surrendered having changed Owners. And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and a Mast, and that her length is 136 feet her breadth 26 feet her depth 10 feet her height 10 feet and that she measures 281 tons and 24 hundredths,
